OLD BUSINESS

Norris gave an update on the FAA legislation which has passed the US Senate, but as of the meeting date had not been acted upon in the House of Representatives. The bill as currently drawn up will have a number of restrictive provisions which the AMA will most likely lobby to have amended or stricken. The tenor of the bill appears to be directed at controlling the future commercial use of drones, as well as the risk to both commercial and general aviation operations. There are obviously some security considerations as well.

The lawn mover blades have been replaced, and it was hoped that the field could be mowed as soon as the 23rd of April subject to the weather cooperating. Shed maintenance and work on the pin board still need to be done, and Bill Sherman is going to put together a list of materials needed to take care of the items.

Field rolling will most likely take place before the middle of May, and once this is done, the club members are encouraged to sign up for mowing the field so that flight operations can take place for the club members.

NEW BUSINESS

The members present decided to go forward with a FUN FLY on the third weekend in June. This will give the club two events to enjoy during the summer flying season. More discussion is to take place at the next meeting scheduled for May 18th at the field.
